



English	<b>To write a narrative with suspense and Mystery</b>	What is a narrative? How can you portray emotion through narrative writing? How can you create mystery and suspense? How can you hook your reader?	Narrative, mystery, suspense, emotive language, beginning, middle, end
Maths	<b>Place Value</b> How can numbers up to 1,000 be represented, partitioned and ordered?	What does place value mean? How can I use concrete resources to represent different numbers? How do you partition different numbers? What is the same about counting in 10's and 100's? What is the same about counting in 5's and 50's?	Place value, digits, base 10, cubes, partition, counting, estimating, number line, 100, 1000.
Science	<b>Animals including humans</b> How do you know the person next to you is alive?	What do humans need to survive? Is the food humans need the same as other animals? What does a balanced diet look like? Can you locate different bones in the body? How do muscles work? Is the human skeleton the same as an animal skeleton?	Humans, animals, skeletons, balanced diet, nutrition, muscle, investigation.
History	<b>Ancient Egypt</b> What achievements were there in early civilisation?	When did the ancient Egyptian era begin? How did ancient Egyptians prosper? What was life like for the different groups in the society? What are hieroglyphics and how were they used? Who and how were the pyramids built? What did ancient Egyptians believe about the afterlife?	Timeline, civilisation, society, river Nile, rulers, pharaohs, afterlife, creation, mummies, ceremonies, tomb.
Religious Education	<b>Hinduism</b> What does it mean to be Hindu?	Where was Hinduism founded? What is the significance of Brahma? Where do Hindus worship? Which kind of festivals do Hindus celebrate? What is the significance of the Aum symbol?	Hindu, worship, holi, Diwali, Brahma, Vishnu, Shiva, celebrations, mandir, belief.
