Learning topic (big question)		Key questions	
Communication and language	Can I retell my favourite story or sing my favourite nursery rhyme?	Do you have a favourite nursery rhyme? Can you change the words? Can you sing it fast or slow? I wonder if we can add actions to the song?	Rhyme, nursery rhyme words, beginning, middle, end.
Personal, social and emotional development	Can I communicate with others to begin to solve minor conflicts with others?	How can you ask this person if you can play with them? I wonder what we could use to help us share the toy? What can we do if someone is using something we want to play with? I wonder how that makes them feel?	Play, share, communicate, invite, friend, independent, zones of regulation.
Physical development	Can I make healthy choices about food and drink?	Which food is healthy/unhealthy and why? Which food is your favourite?	Healthy, unhealthy, fruit names, food names and types.
Maths	Can I count up to six objects confidently and accurately?	How many can you see? Can you count the objects and check? I wonder how many we have? Can you show me six on a ten frame?	Number names up to five, subitise, count, total, more, less, smaller, bigger
Literacy	Do I understand that print carries meaning and can I point it out in my environment?	I wonder what the sign says? Can you find the words in the book?	letter, sound, names, signs
Understanding the world	Can I care for living things?	How can we look after living things? What do plants need to grow? What tools did Jasper use in the story 'Jasper's beanstalk'?	plants, life cycle, leaves, stem, flower, care, habitat
Expressive arts and design	Can I build stories around my small world play?	What else could you add to your construction/small world scene? Can we add any more features, e.g. grass, leaves etc. Can you describe what you have built/made?	press, print, thread, mark, join, paint, cut, build, mix, design
